MEPcontent browser apps technical information

System requirements

Operating system:

- Microsoft® Windows® 10 (64-bits) versie 1809 or higher.
- Microsoft® Windows® 11 (ARM-processors are not supported)

Autodesk Platforms (Revit and AutoCAD):

In general the MEPcontent browser app will support the latest **four** versions of Revit and AutoCAD. Please check this website for the current ones:

Installation Permissions:

Per machine requires administrative rights of your company, per user requires no administrative rights, you can install the App yourself as a user.

Internet/Firewall:

Communication over port 443 to the following domains:

Proxy:

The app can be used in a proxy enabled environment, it will ask for credentials upon startup. Proxies are detected in the standard browser application that is used for identification.

Installer

Installer type: signed executable or .exe

The installation program guides the user through the following screens:

- Welcome
- Files in use (AutoCAD or Revit are opened)
- EULA (End user License Agreement)
- Installation scope
- Ready to install
- Installing
- Completed Setup Wizard

Installation Scope

The user can select the platform on which the App will be installed, this can be AutoCAD and/or Revit. Depending on the App platform selection between Revit or AutoCAD will be available or not. Most Apps are only built for Revit, in that case the user will see the platform selection box, but it will be grayed out and the selection cannot be adjusted. In the same screen the user can select if the App is installed for all users of the computer (machine install), or just for the current user. This selection can only be changed for new installations, when an update is performed it has to be done in the same user context. Administrative rights are required when installing for all users.

Silent Installation

<FULL_PATH_TO_EXE> <ACTION> -silent -norestart INSTALLDIRAPP="<INSTALL_DIR>" PERUSER=<0=PerMachine 1=PerUser> INSTALLADDINFORREVIT=<0=No 1=Yes> INSTALLPLUGINFORACAD=<0=No 1=Yes>

<Action> Possible values = -uninstall, -install, -repair, -update

Example (version 12.15.0.908):

MEPcontent Browser 12.15.0.908 -silent -norestart PERUSER=0 INSTALLADDINFORREVIT=1  
INSTALLPLUGINFORACAD=1 INSTALLDIRAPP="C:\Program Files\trimble\MEPcontent"
```
